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A Chat with Chef-owner

PETRINA LOH OF MORSELS

Petrina Loh, chef-owner of fusion restaurant Morsels at Dempsey Hill recently took the coveted prize for Restaurant of the Year at the recent World Gourmet Summit. Chef Petrina also picked up the Chef's Choice (Western award), which fellow chefs vote on. It has been a long but rewarding journey for this intrepid business owner.



When did you know you wanted to be a chef?

Chef Loh: After being in banking for eight years, I started yearning for a change and thought about opening a restaurant. People told me how restaurateurs are often held ransom by chefs. So, I decided to equip myself with the skills to be a chef and a business owner. I've always loved cooking; my late dad taught me how. He used to bring me to wet markets and his favourite hawker stalls and I've had a keen palate ever since.

What was the most difficult thing you had to do in order to follow your dream?

Chef Loh: I had a MAS scholarship and was bonded for two years after doing my masters in wealth management at SMU. About a year into the bond, I decided to change my career before turning 30. With my mum's blessing, I returned to San Francisco to study culinary arts.

Are there advantages of being a "late starter"

Chef Loh: There are head chefs who started out when they were 18 or 19. I knew I had to work harder and learn faster. Staying on course requires tenacity and enough humility to take instructions from more experienced professionals. However, my age and work/ life experiences also helped me. I have well-honed management skills because I worked in a corporate setting. And having to dine at different restaurants for business really sharpened my palate.

What advice would you give to those who want to follow your path?

Chef Loh: A very strong will, a fiery passion for food, and never say die!

Would you say that women have to fight harder for opportunities in this industry? Why?

Chef Loh: People often mistake me for a pastry chef – perhaps because I am a woman. Being a woman in this field means having to be tough and focused in order to earn respect from our peers. I believe that if I just keep doing what I do, the opportunities will present themselves.

If you could start over, what would you change? *Chef Loh:* Trust myself, and not expect someone else, to run my restaurant.

Where do you get the inspiration for your concepts? How do you come up with new dishes? Chef Loh: It helps to stage at certain restaurants at least once a year. There's always more to learn from other chefs and members of your own team.

Who are your role models?

Chef Loh: Walter Abrams from Spruce in San Francisco was one of the first chefs to train me. He taught me what was needed in the kitchen and about life. Another role model is executive chef Mark Sullivan of The Bacchus Management Group, which owns Spruce and Village Pub, both one-starred Michelin restaurants. I also admire Dominique Crenn of Atelier Crenn, Torsten Vildgaard of Studio Copenhagen, Evan Rich of Rich Table, and Stuart Brioza of State Bird, who taught me that when it comes to flavour combinations, the sky's the limit!

Why did you move Morsels to Dempsey Hill?

Chef Loh: The shophouse at Mayo Street suffered some structural damage due to the construction of the MRT nearby. Around this time, I saw this spot at Dempsey that was available – a standalone house has been around for many years. That sealed the deal for me because I love old buildings.

What's next for Morsels? Could you share your plans for the future?

Chef Loh: We're starting wine dinner events and are working on a delivery service. Weekday lunch and weekend brunch were introduced in February, and we will soon launch our four-seater Chef's Table in April. Meantime, we just want to enjoy being in Dempsey and to continue feeding our guests good food paired with our curated list of wines, sake, gins, and liquors.

How to Buy Antiques by SHANG ANTIQUES

A key concern collectors have about buying antiques is how to distinguish the real deal from the fakes. Fred Chua, Founder of Shang Antiques at Dempsey Hill has been in the business of sourcing for and selling antiques for more than 30 years. He says there are three main things to look out for:

Patina

This is a thin layer that forms on the surface of stone or wood as a result of oxidisation. You can tell how old an antique is by the thickness of the patina. Wood tends to have a very nice wearing over time, while a bronze piece tends to have a green or blue patina.

Style

Before you commit to buying an antique, you need to find out about the period it was crafted in. Countries go through different economic periods and this is sometimes reflected in the art.

inish

In the old days, craftsmen took great pride in their work and made sure that every corner was sanded, smoothed, and finished to perfection. When you are buying an antique, touch the surfaces and check the insides and bottom of the piece. Another important thing to look out for is signs of repair – some old pieces may have had repairs done. If more than 60 per cent of the repairs were made using new wood, the item may not be worth the high price.
